ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **MASS Teacher Training Institute, Chennai Salai, Koranattu Karuppur Via, Kumbakonam, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary Course of two years duration** from the academic session **2004-05** for an intake of **50**.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
- The institution has created an Endowment fund of Rs.5.00 lakhs and an Reserve fund of Rs.89,83,612.
- The institution has selected the principal and five teachers for the said course and the staff list is not approved by the DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **MASS Teacher Training Institute, Chennai Salai, Koranattu Karuppur Via, Kumbakonam, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu** to offer **Elementary** course of two years duration from the academic session **2004-05** with an annual intake of **50** students, subject to fulfillment of the following.

- The institution will ensure that 6 exclusive faculty members duly approved by the State Board are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course. The faculty list is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

c) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

7. Recognition is subject to the outcome of petition(s) for Special Leave to Appeal (civil) No.13271/2004
